WAILING WOMEN WORLDWIDE FIRST QUARTER ALL-NIGHT

The Quarterly All-Night Prayer Meeting of Wailing Women Worldwide, hosted by CRAN, was successfully held in March 2026, bringing together approximately thirty-five (35) participants, excluding children. The gathering was marked by a deeply enriching spiritual atmosphere, as participants were ushered into God's presence through powerful sessions of praise and worship.

The sermon was delivered by Dr. Genevieve Adukpo, CRAN's board chairperson, on the theme, "How to Hear from God," drawing from 1 Samuel 3:10-11 and Joshua 1:1-9. She reflected on the life of Samuel, highlighting his humility and service in the house of God. Dr. Adukpo explained how Samuel initially heard God's voice but did not recognize it, repeatedly seeking guidance until he was taught how to respond.

This powerful illustration addressed a key question: How do we hear from God? She noted that while God often speaks, many believers fail to discern His voice. Like Samuel, Christians must cultivate sensitivity and a readiness to respond. His response, "Speak, for your servant is listening," exemplifies a posture of surrender and attentiveness.

Dr. Adukpo encouraged participants, as Wailing Women, to intentionally position themselves to hear God clearly and distinctly, fostering a deeper and more intimate relationship with Him.



Dr. Adukpo further emphasized that hearing from God requires attentive ears and a receptive heart. Believers are called to intentionally create space for God through consistent study and meditation on His Word, as well as through fasting and prayer. These spiritual disciplines draw individuals closer to Him and sharpen their ability to discern His voice.

Dr. Adukpo concluded by encouraging all participants to remain committed to the daily study and meditation of the Word of God, stressing that this is key to hearing His voice clearly and consistently. CRAN is honoured to partner with the Wailing Women for a successful program.

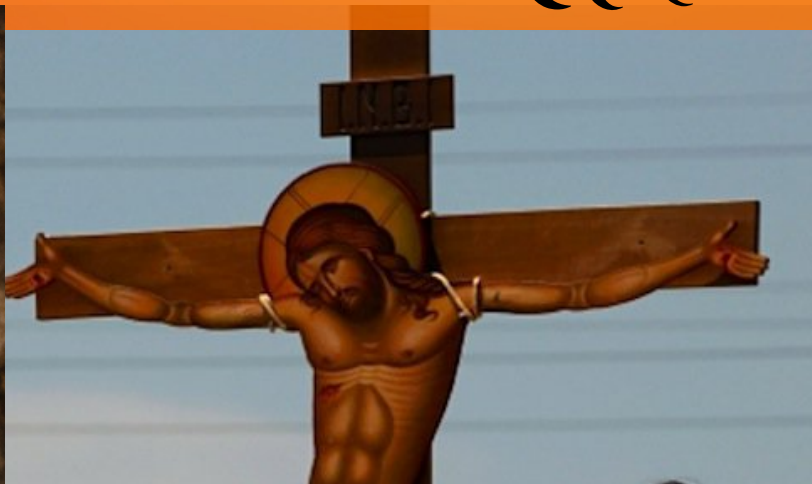
